



SECOND DISTRICT CLUBS YEARBOOK COMPETITION 2019

A club yearbook should be an easy to use source of information for the club year, planned to inspire members to attend meetings and to participate in club activities. It is a combination package presenting a picture of the club's goals, the continuity of its objectives from year to year, and details on meetings, members and special events. It is hoped that each club will consider publishing an annual yearbook, even though it may not plan to compete for a yearbook award. The purpose of the club's yearbook is to summarize the year's plans and provide information for ready reference.

All clubs in the district are welcome to apply for a Yearbook Award. This chairman will need to have the club's applications by **May 1st**, so that I can arrange to have them evaluated by our judges and returned upstate by the June deadline. The yearbooks are judged by our accredited judges at the district level and then this Yearbook Chairman forwards the winning entries in each category to the FGCNYS Yearbook Chairman.
